#### **HOW TO ARRIVE TO DEBRECEN BY AIR:**

- **DEBRECEN AIRPORT** situated 10 km from the center of Debrecen.
- **BUDAPEST AIRPORT LISZT FERENC -** situated 220 km from Debrecen (approx 2,5 hour transfer time).

The event manager for accommodation and transport, Mr. Zoltan Timar will organize transport from **BUDAPEST AIRPORT** to Debrecen and back.

You need to contact Mr. Zoltan Timar before 10<sup>th</sup> March 2024 to book transportation and to find out information about the prices. After this date the prices will be 50% higher.

The price depends on the type of transport and number of people travelling (Car: max 4 people, minibus: 7-8 people, minibus: 17 people, Coach/Bus: 35 people, Coach/Bus: 49 people).

Budapest airport: car: € 50 /person (2 people/car), € 30 / person (4 people/car)

minibus 7-8 people: € 30 / person, minibus 15-17 people: € 30 / person

Bus/coach more than 20 people: € 30 / person

**Debrecen airport to Debrecen accommodation**: return ticket €10/person

If the distance between the accommodation and the Sport's hall requires daily transportation extra costs will apply.

#### **ACCOMMODATION**

All the participants: competitors, coaches, referees and officials have the chance to book various types of accommodation in City of Debrecen or max. 30 km from sport's hall. The price is different according to the type of the room and number of the persons accommodated in the room.



#### **VISA**

Participants who need a **VISA** must contact the organizer as soon as possible, time delays may result in your visa not being granted in time for the event. **This is your responsibility.** 

#### **OFFICIALS**

The Chief referee will approve registered referees and judges, SKDUN qualified referees and judges will have their previously issued ID and qualification badges, these will allow automatic entry as SKDUN officials to all areas of the venue as required. Please remember to bring your SKDUN official issued ID and tie, red for referees and blue for judges and your whistle.

Referees and Judges will need to register on Sportdata before 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024.

Make sure to include only the days when you will be available. IMPORTANT, please let the Chief referee designate, Mihaela Popescu know in advance if you have registered but cannot attend due to illness, work etc. Those who are also competing (only allowed in Asai Ryu/Veteran categories, no other categories), please let her know in which categories you entered in order for her to accurately schedule and designate officials to the various tatami.

- + € 10 for individual events.
- + € 25 for team events.

Registration fees for coaches – € 30 per coach.

To protest - € 50 per protest (only one protest is allowed during one match if the protest is not correct).
